So paying it forward is what we hold in our hearts without hesitation in helping however and whenever may be, if God permits us to. My children and I are strong believers any kind of life is number one priority. So at Las Islas we are making something wonderful happen,” shares Bella.

Weeks after Hurricane Maria carved a wide swath of destruction across Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands, the American Red Cross continues to work alongside partner agencies to aid survivors. The Red Cross has served more than 615,000 meals and snacks, distributed more than 2.4 million relief supplies like cleanup supplies, tarps, insect repellent, etc. and provided nearly 15,000 mental health and health services to people in need. Right now, more than 880 Red Cross disaster workers are helping on the islands as of October 31st.
